KENTUCKY BOURBON

7 Days - 6 Nights

The sample itinerary described below is approximately like the itinerary your group will be following during your stay with WHITE STAR TOURS. However, the exact times, days, and destinations may vary for your group.

- Day 1 Depart from your hometown and travel to your overnight stop for lodging (pack an overnight bag); dinner is on your own this evening.
- Day 2 Enjoy breakfast, then check out and continue traveling to **Louisville, KY** where lodging has been arranged for you the next two nights. After check-in at your hotel, you will have time to freshen up before departing for a scenic **dinner cruise aboard the Belle of Louisville steamboat**. Return to your hotel for a restful evening after the cruise.
- Day 3 Following breakfast, you will depart for the **Kentucky Bourbon Trail Welcome Center** at the Frazier Museum to begin your tour of bourbon distilleries. Kentucky is the birthplace of Bourbon and produces 95% of the Bourbon in the world. During your Kentucky Bourbon Trail, you will discover how Bourbon became America's only true native spirit. Today you will be visiting **two distilleries** in the Louisville area. **Dinner** is included this evening.
- Day 4 After breakfast, you will check out and travel towards Shepherdsville. Arrive in nearby Clermont to visit the **Jim Beam American Stillhouse** to experience two centuries of history, heritage and craftsmanship of America's #1 bourbon, which you will be sampling. View the bourbon-making process firsthand and witness what goes into creating an authentic liquid legend. You will have an up-close and personal look into the long lineage of the First Family of Bourbon, their business, and its impact on Kentucky and the bourbon industry. After your visit, travel to Bardstown with a lunch stop on your own along the way. Upon arrival in Bardstown you will visit the **Heaven Hill Distillery** which was founded in 1935. An experienced host will guide you through the history and heritage of America's original whiskey. An educational bourbon tasting is included. After the tour, you will check into your hotel in the Bardstown area and freshen up before departing for a delicious **dinner** in the area.
- Day 5 Enjoy breakfast, then depart for a visit to the **Oscar Getz Museum of Whiskey History**. The Museum displays a 50-year collection of rare artifacts and documents concerning the American whiskey industry dating from pre-Colonial days to post-Prohibition years. The museum includes exhibits on President Washington, Abraham Lincoln, authentic moonshine stills, antique bottles and jugs, medicinal whiskey bottles, unique advertising art, novelty whiskey containers, and much more. After your visit, you will head to the **Bardstown Bourbon Company** for a Napa Valley-style experience that features a state-of-the-art bourbon distillery which is both modern and authentic. Bardstown Bourbon Company is set on 100 acres of active farmland in the heart of the Bourbon Capital of the World and produces the highest-quality Kentucky bourbon, whiskey, and rye brands. Enjoy lunch on your own in the area, then depart for an afternoon visit to the **Old Kentucky Home State Park**. The park's centerpiece is *Federal Hill*, a farm owned by U.S. Senator John Rowan in 1795 when the mansion became a meeting place for local politicians and visiting dignitaries. The farm is best known for its association with American composer Stephen Foster's anti-slavery^[4] ballad "My Old Kentucky Home". Foster was a cousin of the Rowan Family. After popularity of the song increased throughout the United States, *Federal Hill* was purchased by the Commonwealth of Kentucky, dedicated as a historic site, and renamed "**My Old Kentucky Home"** in 1923. A **tour of the mansion** is included. Your day will end with a delicious dinner in the area, followed by a relaxing evening.
- Day 6 Following breakfast, check out and travel to your last night of lodging for check-in (pack an overnight bag); dinner is on your own tonight.
- Day 7 After breakfast, check out and depart for home with lasting memories of the Kentucky Bourbon Trail.
